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Children's summer reading program requirements

The summer reading program is available to children of all ages. To promote reading during the summer, the library offers books, programs and entertainment. Since summer is for fun, the library offers small prizes to children who read the required number of books. These are the requirements.

The READ- To- Me Program (children who do not read on their own)

To receive a prize, 15 books need to be read to them.
Sheets are available to keep track of books. Sheets are to be turned in to receive a prize.

I Can Read Program (beginning readers who use I can read books)

To receive a prize, children need to read 5 ICR books.
Sheets are turned in to receive prize.

Chapter books readers

Children can set their own goals in this program. They can decide how many books they want to read to gain a prize. At least one chapter book is required to earn a prize.

All reading is done at your own pace. Over the summer, most children visit the treasure box multiple times. The treasure box opens July 1st and closes August 19th.
