2. Director's Report:

Friends of the Library will discontinue the chess program. This is an expensive program and of the 3 Greenland participants only one is not already a member of the chess club. Mr. Norton is now running an after school chess program at the school on Fridays.

Kudos to Matt Sargent who coordinated the Fall cleanup with the Parish House cleanup, garnered the help of the Webelos1 Scouts and their parents, and provided equipment and labor, and along with some community volunteers prepared the grounds for winter.

The ice and wind storm has knocked the seat from its supports and deposited a variety of pine branches at back of the building. No other damage was realized.

3. The majority of the meeting was of concern about our preparation of the 2009 budget. Due to illness, power outages and other unknown circumstances questions remain unanswered making final preparation difficult if not impossible at this time. After much discussion it was agreed to follow the Town's direction and request the same Health Insurance plan as that offered Town employees with the understanding that Short Term Disability and Dental can be added at any time. Peter Chapel (Local Government Center) has not yet been available to meet with the Director and Trustee representative. Denise has had to spend many hours of her own time working on this project and deserves a vote of thanks from all those who enjoy the use of their public library.
